Our range of designs are available in Prime and Rustic grades - shown on page 8
with the majority of items in stock and ready for finishing.

FINISHES

To complete your bespoke floor choose your texture and treatment from page 9 & 10
and your colour and finish from pages 18 to 23.

We use UV cured hardwax oil as our final protective layer, available in;

Matt - The flattest and closest resemblance to woodlook by providing a natural raw matt appearance.

Silk - Over 75% of orders are chosen with this finish.

Now you've chosen your options, our experienced colour technicians will create your wood floor here in the UK, so ensuring the highest British quality and prompt delivery.

THE LAB

Our state of the art Lab houses only the best machinery to achieve our colour matching service. With an extensive range of unfinished European stock in Prime, Rustic and 100% Fumed Oak we can offer you a prompt colour matching service and final production time.

The process of sample matching takes 10 working days as we use the same extensive weighted method of application to ensure precise and consistent application of the oils, stains and textures required.



GRADING

Our prime and rustic grades are determined by the knot, sapwood and colour content.



Prime

Prime grade has few, if any knots, and these will be of minimal size. Core or edge sapwood and filler will be negligible if any at all. There will be a relatively small amount of colour variation in the timber itself with no heart wood.

Rustic

Rustic grade allows for the mixture of natural grain and knots. Sound knots of up to 70mm and dead knots up to 40mm are perfectly acceptable. There will be colour variation and also expect minimal core or edge sapwood, plus filler. The colour of the filler is carefully selected to complement the wood rather than to match it exactly and it may vary from batch to batch.

Grading rules may vary from country to country and manufacturer to manufacturer. Please check at time of placing an order for a certain product / range.



TEXTURES

Our aged and bandsawn floor textures are achieved through using both unique and conventional techniques.



Aged

Each piece of flooring is tumbled and hand worked by our skilled craftsmen to achieve an authentic aged appearance to the edges and surface of the timber. With our colour options you have all the benefits of modern engineered processes with the looks, character and charm of a reclaimed floor.

Bandsawn

The surface of our bandsawn floors replicate traditional cut marks. With the saw marks across the face at an angle of 90° from the length of the board thus creating a beautiful rough-sawn texture. which is available in all design options.

Ideal for flooring or wall cladding in retail or commercial projects. Our bandsawn texture particularly suits retail and commercial projects.

Please be aware that when you buy any of our textured floors variation in texture and colour will occur, this is the beauty of having these floors.

TREATMENTS

Our fumed and smoked colours are achieved through a process which reacts with the natural tannins in the oak and although we use controlled processes, the final colours are dictated by nature and not by using pigmented stains.

The main difference between the two techniques; The Smoking process penetrates the veneer surface by 0.5 - 2mm in depth whilst the image shown here demonstrates that our Fumed Oak penetrates the entire veneer layer.



Light Smoked Surface smoked – tones of light to medium brown.

Medium Smoked Surface smoked – tones of medium to dark brown.

Dark Smoked Surface smoked – tones of dark brown.

Fumed 100% Fumed - tones of deep dark brown/black.

Please be aware that when you buy smoked or fumed oak there will be a large variation in colour, this is the beauty of having these floors.

CHEVRON

With its distinctive 45 degree angle "V" shape pattern, the chevron design is another impressive flooring choice. Evidence indicates that the pattern originated in Greece 1800 BC, when they made their brick roads directional creating an almost linear appearance which in later years crept into flooring design.

Chevron wood flooring is an excellent option when trying to achieve the impression that a room is bigger than in fact it is, or to create an optical illusion that it's wider or longer.
